Proposed Amendment to STARS Constitution

STARS has established the 'STARS of Waverley Fund' for the purpose of providing financial support to new and emerging artists and performers in our region. The Fund was initially established with a contribution from two of our members. The fund has been augmented from time to time with donations and contributions from members and from the proceeds of STARS activities. A number of grants have been made from the Fund over the past 4 years.

It is proposed that STARS apply to the Commonwealth Government to allow that donations from eligible persons be tax deductible to those donors. To this end it is necessary for STARS to amend its Constitution.

The proposed amendment is to be put before members at the STARS Annual General Meeting.

MOTION: That the Constitution of Southern Theatre and Arts Supporters Incorporated be amended by the insertion of the following clauses –

- 4.4 To receive public donations to a gift fund specifically established for the purpose of providing grants to new and emerging artists and performers in support of their skill and talent development.
- 4.5 If the fund mentioned in Clause 4.4 is wound up or if the endorsement (if any) of the Association as a deductible gift recipient for the operation of the fund is revoked, any surplus assets of the gift fund remaining after payment of liabilities attributable to it, shall be transferred to a fund to which income tax deductible gifts can be made.

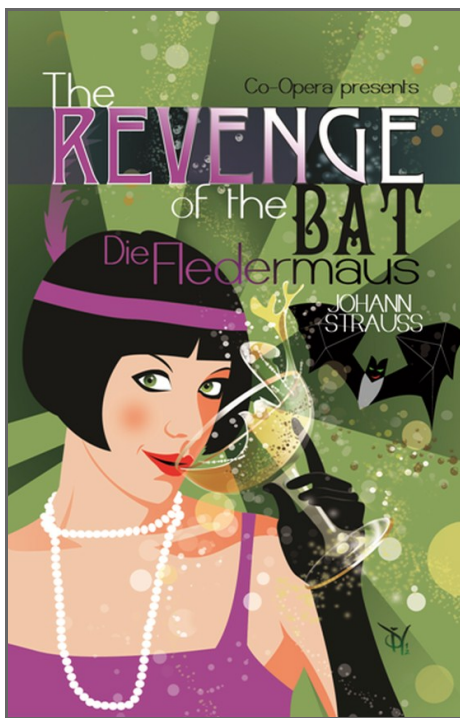
