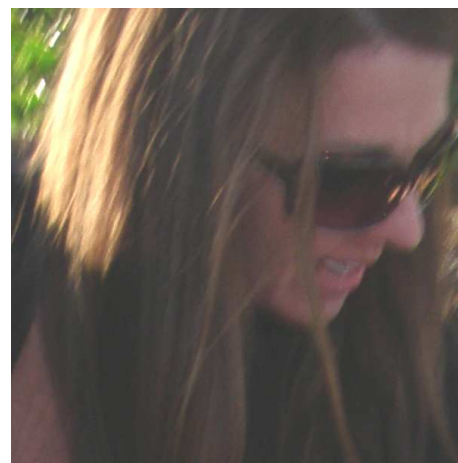

The Exhibition will be launched on Saturday 3 August and will continue each Saturday and Sunday until 31 August.

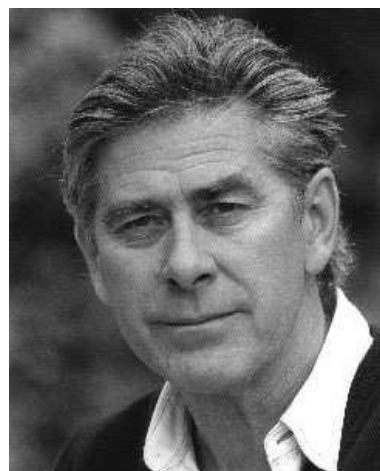


STARS Programme 2013 Launch
