“MAKING MOZART’ in the Institute McLaren Vale Saturday 24 May

STARS presented The Da Ponte Project Making Mozart at the McLaren Vale Institute where a large crowd of all ages showed a great deal of enthusiasm for this new production. The premiere of this quirky and clever concert, written by Ewart Shaw was held in October last year and members of STARS were keen to present it to the local arts-loving audience in the southern region.

From the very outset, the audience members were receptive and appreciative of the quality of the production and especially the calibre of the international singers, among them local resident Catriona Barr mezzo and an identity in the wine industry as well as a beautiful opera singer. Mario charmed his way through the evening winning all of the female audience and probably most of the men. The cast received a standing ovation and the feedback has been brilliant.

The Institute provided an elegant venue for the presentation of the Mozart favourites and STARS will continue to stage concerts in the venue recognising the potential for larger audiences than Waverley Homestead can support. STARS hosted a bar and presented a Lottery which will boost funds for further productions in the second half of the year and in 2015.






