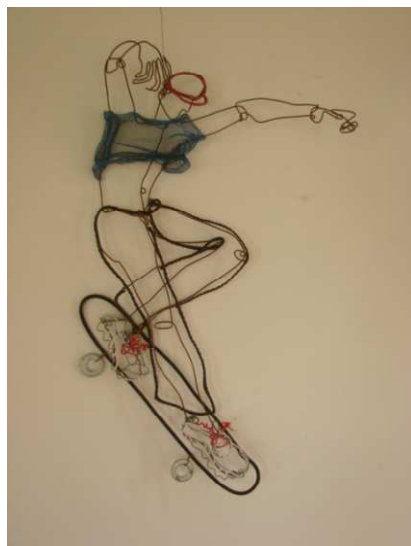

All the World's a Stage Quiz Night will be held on 17 August at 6.30 pm tickets \$25.00 including soup. BOOK EARLY



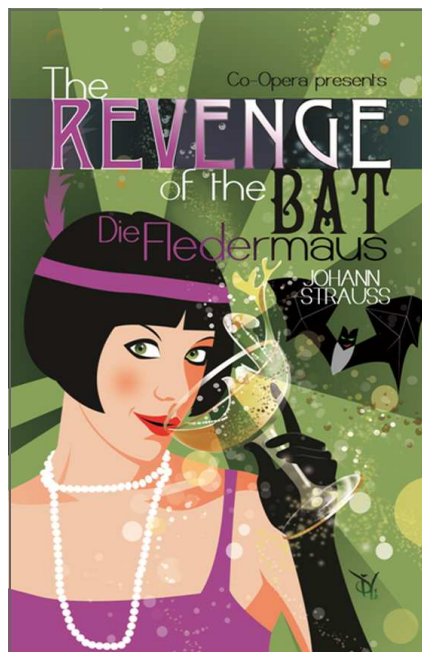

Sunday 30 June at 2.30 pm

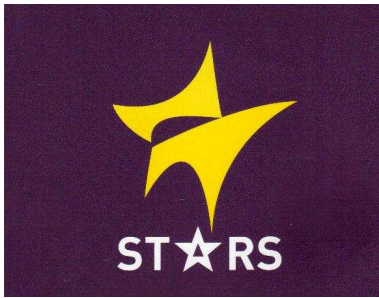
